Course Information and assignments

It is a 3 credit course (WLL495 and WLL695) and includes several assignments.

Itinerary and Locations

May 20 (Tues.): Depart the United States

May 21 (Wed.): Stay in Tokyo (partner school visits, traditional music workshop, etc.)

May 25 (Sun.): Stay in Kanazawa (partner school visit, traditional cultural workshop, etc.)

May 27 (Tues.): Stay in Osaka, Kyoto, Nara, Hyogo (calligraphy workshop, etc.) May 31 (Sat.): Stay in Hiroshima (Peace Memorial Museum, Miyajima, etc.)

June 3 (Tues.): Return to the United States via Tokyo Haneda Airport

Transportation and Housing in Japan

Local public transportation and taxi in cities as well as bullet trains between cities will be available. Double-occupancy rooms will be accommodated. Breakfast is not included.

Things to Consider

There is a lot of walking (at least 4-5 miles every day) during the program. There are many cultural differences to understand and respect. The passport must be valid before travel.

Cost

\$3,500 (including \$500 deposit; non-refundable) must be paid to the University in advance. It covers domestic transportation and housing, activity fees, accompaniment of faculty, travel insurance, tuition and admission processing fees, excursions and some group meals. International flights and meals are NOT included.
