



Certificate in Gaming Management

The Certificate in Gaming Management offers the training necessary for upward mobility in the gaming profession and affords you the opportunity to be recognized for your commitment, knowledge and desire for career advancement. The program also allows you to continue working while gaining the knowledge, skills and attitudes necessary for management positions.



Certificate Requirements:

To earn a certificate in Gaming Management, a participant must complete:

- **90** or more non-credit hours of instruction acquired by attendance in any Gaming Management course offered by the University of Nevada, Reno. This can be a combination of weeklong courses (typically 30 hours each), short courses (typically 7-14 hours each), online courses (typically 15 hours each), customized in-house offerings or the Executive Development Program. Restrictions apply for repeated courses. Please contact us for details.
- Submittal of a three-page paper* on the regulatory structure and legal environment of the gaming jurisdiction in which you currently work. *This requirement does not apply if you attend the Executive Development Program.*

*Your paper should be typed, three pages in length and double spaced. Please include in your paper a brief history of gaming in your jurisdiction and a discussion of the regulatory structure and legal environment under which your property operates. This may include, but is not limited to:

- number of licenses granted
- general restrictions, rules and guidelines
- market share and competitors
- taxation structure
- current and future challenges
